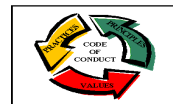
YIDARRA'S SOCIAL EXPECTATIONS

Seminar Series (L2) 1 - 3

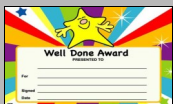

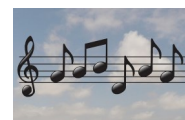
