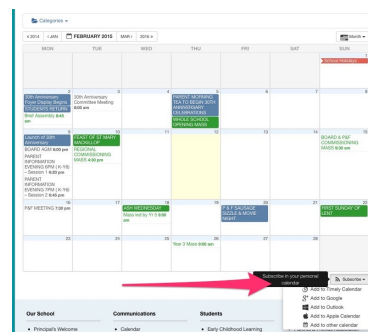

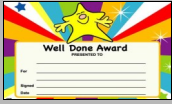
- Baptism (please see your Parish Priest)
