Our Semester Student Reports will be available electronically through a reporting component of the SEQTA suite known as Coneqtp. A letter, which you should receive in the next couple of days, will be posted to all families with children in Pre-Primary to Year Six. This letter contains all of the information that you should require to logon to access your child's report which will be available online from Friday 3rd July. If you do not receive the letter it will probably be because we have incorrect contact details for you and we request that you contact the school office if this is the case. We ask that you go in to the parental portal to test your log in and to change your password from Friday 26th June. If you experience any difficulties with logging onto the parent portal please contact the school office and we will assist you. As this is a new system wide initiative we do expect some teething problems so we will be most appreciative of your patience and support with the implementation of this new form of reporting.

2017 YIDARRA 4 YEAR OLD KINDERGARTEN ENROLMENTS

A reminder that an application for enrolment form should be lodged at Yidarra no later than FRIDAY 3 July 2015.

In 2017, the 2 Yidarra Kindergarten classes will operate on 3 full days per week on **Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday, 8.55am-2.45pm**. To be eligible for Kindergarten 2017, your child's birthday must fall between **1 July 2012 – 30 June 2013**.

An application form and enrolment information package may be collected from the Yidarra office between 8am-4pm Mon-Fri, or you may arrange for it to be posted to you by phoning 9332 3011.

A reminder to families, who do not have other children already at Yidarra, that they need to organise a Parish Priest's Reference form, if they have not already done so. They can make an appointment with one of the Priests at the Bateman Parish by phoning the St Thomas More Parish office on 9310 1747.

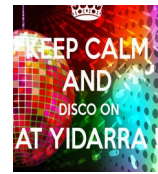

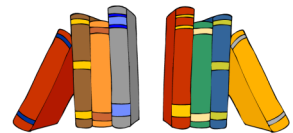

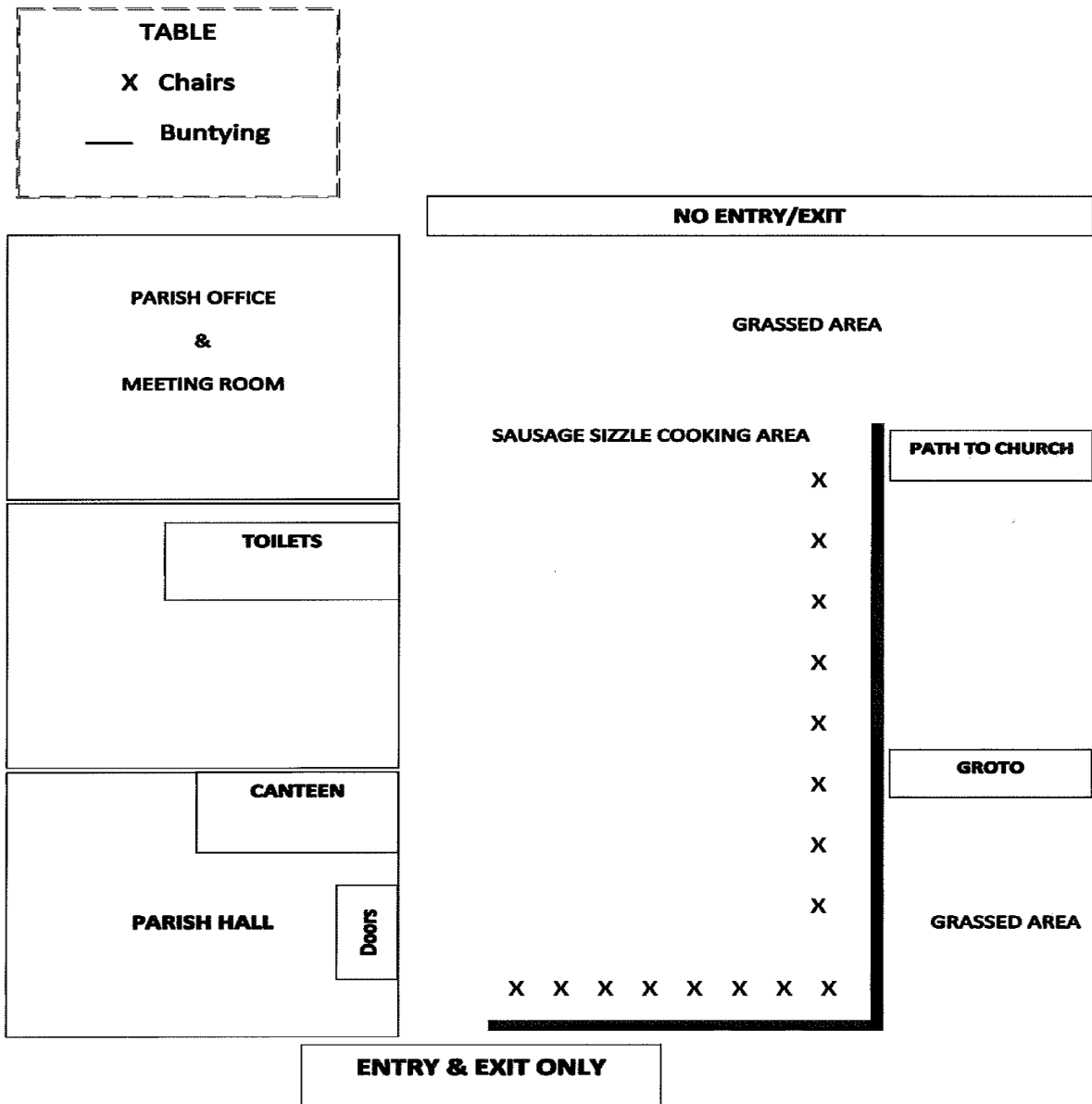
